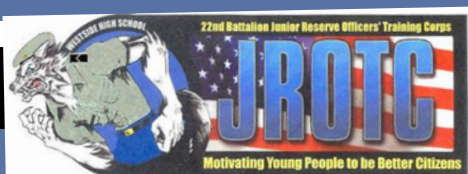

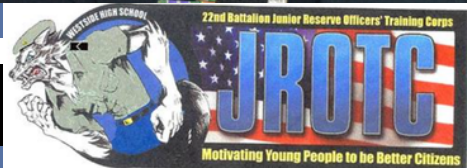
9/11 CEREMONY

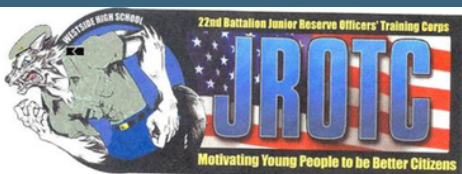
