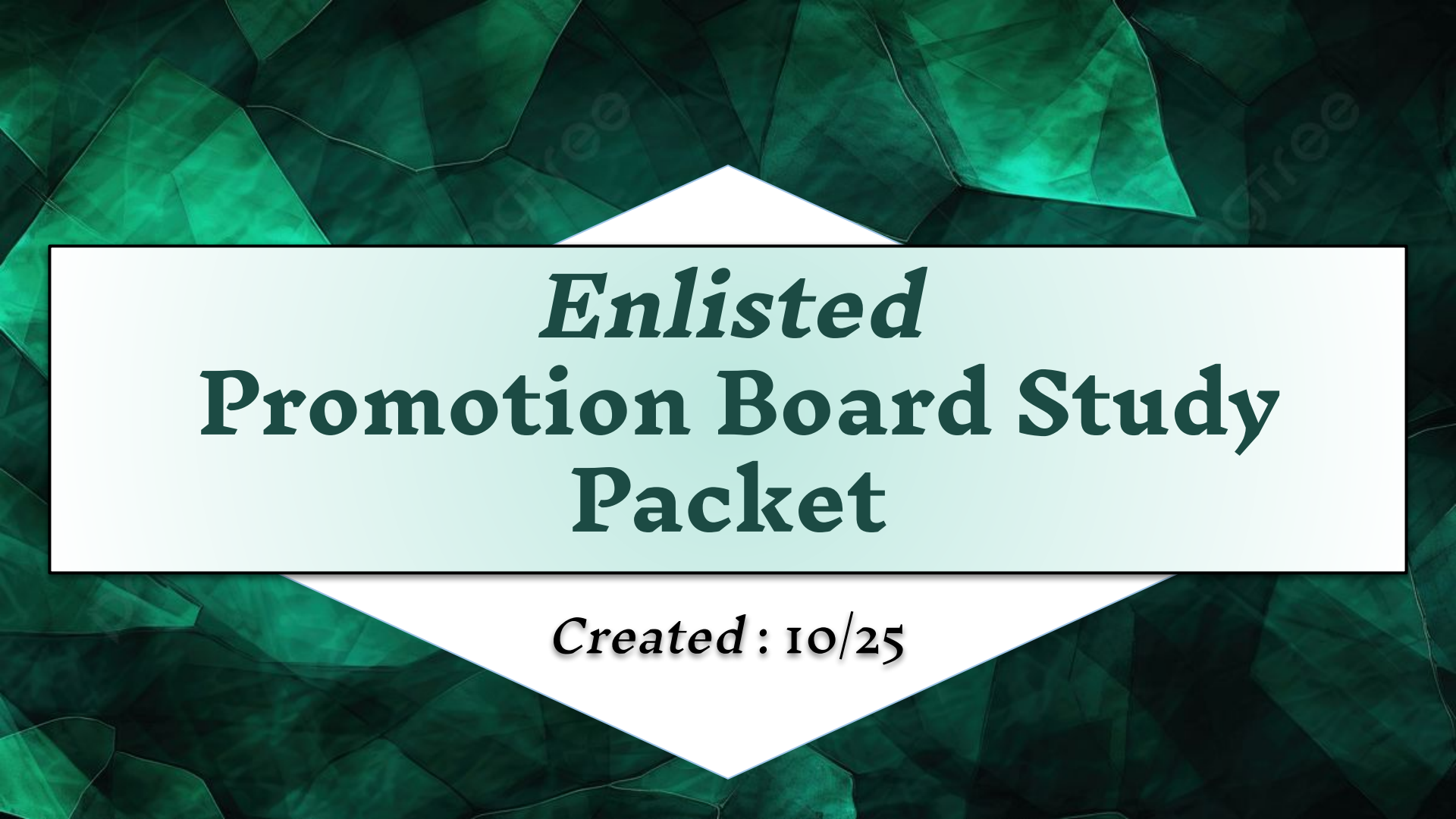

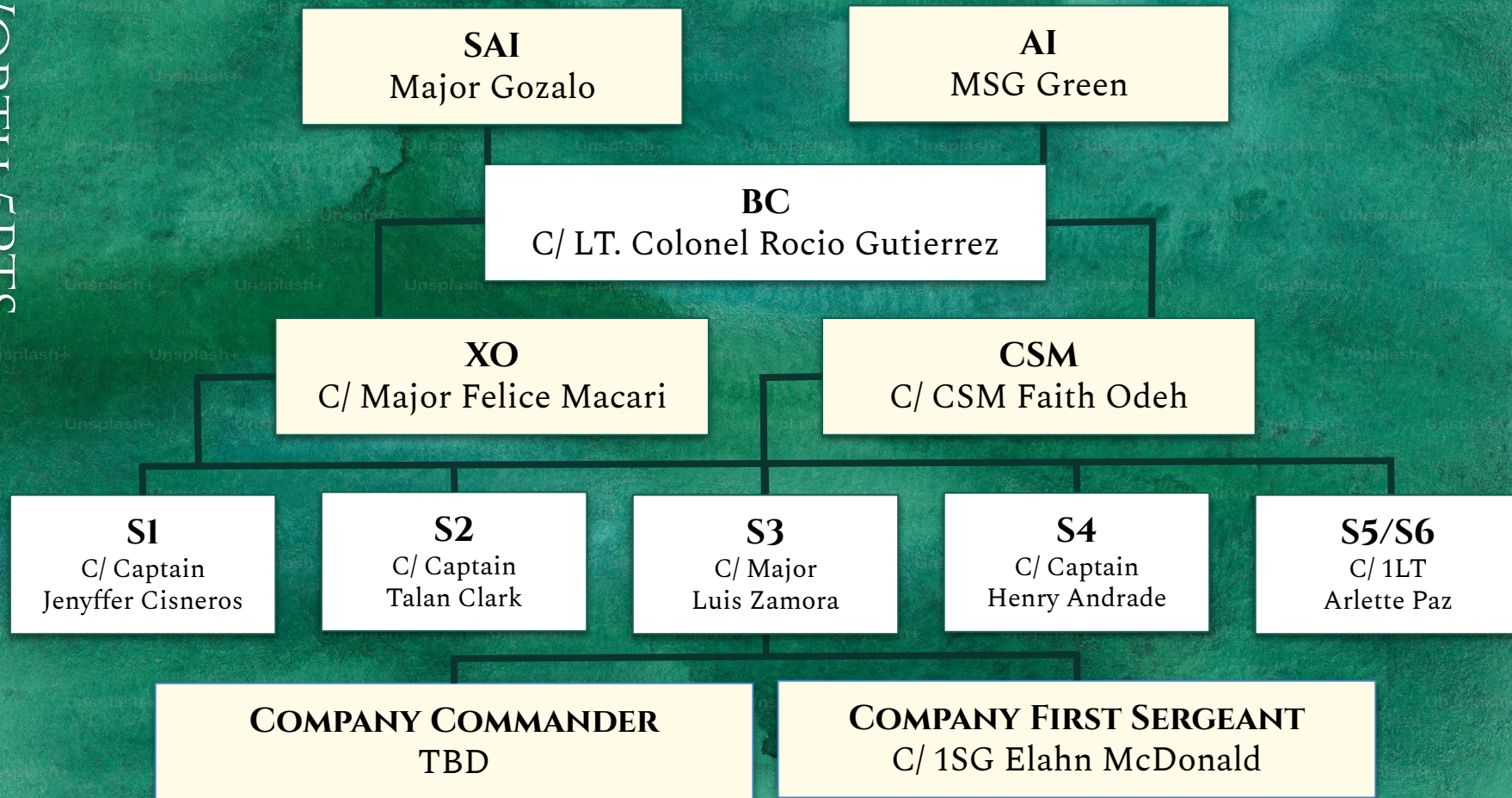

LOCAL

1. Polk Street Closure Approved

The Houston City Council approved closing part of *Polk Street* to allow *expansion of the George R. Brown Convention Center*, despite community concerns about traffic and accessibility.

2. Houston City Council Avoids Property Tax Increase

At the request of Mayor John Whitmire, the Houston City Council voted against raising property taxes despite facing a \$128 million budget deficit. The goal is to *reduce financial strain* on residents.

NATIONAL

1. Federal Government Shutdown

Congress *didn't pass the new budget in time*, so the government shut down. Many *federal workers are temporarily out of work*, and places like the National Zoo are closed until a deal is made.

2. Rare-Earth Mineral Deal with Australia

The U.S. and Australia sealed a major deal worth about \$8.5 *billion* for rare earth minerals, aiming to reduce dependence on China for those resources.
